Annual Admission Passes for purchase at a discounted rate

- Maximum of **TWO** pass discounts per household for Duke of Gloucester Society (Gifts of \$100 through \$249.99), Colonial Williamsburg Capitol Society (gifts of \$250 through \$499.99), Colonial Williamsburg Assembly (gifts of \$500-\$999.99), Colonial Williamsburg Burgesses (gifts of \$1,000 through \$1,775.99), Colonial Williamsburg Burgesses 1776 Circle (gifts of \$1,776 through \$2,499.99), and Colonial Williamsburg Associates (\$2,500 through \$3,499.99) members
- Maximum of **THREE** pass discounts per household for Colonial Williamsburg Associates - Governor's Circle members
- Maximum of **FOUR** pass discounts per household for Raleigh Tavern Society members
- Pass discount codes are issued at the beginning of the membership period.
- **A valid Supporter Card must be presented at a ticket location to redeem.**

Donor Annual Admission Pass with full pass benefits

- A valid supporter card with a ticket icon counts as the donor annual pass. Those with this type of supporter card do not need to redeem vouchers. They may go straight into the Historic Area and use their valid card as their pass.
- No physical pass vouchers will be provided
- Maximum of **ONE** donor pass per household for members of the Colonial Williamsburg Capitol Society (gifts of \$250 through \$499.99) and the Colonial Williamsburg Assembly (gifts of \$500-\$999.99)
- Maximum of **TWO** donor passes per household for donors who give more than \$1,000 (Colonial Williamsburg Burgesses, Colonial Williamsburg Associates and Raleigh Tavern Society)

Annual passes for guests

- Pass discount codes are issued at the beginning of the membership period.
- **A valid Supporter Card must be presented at a ticket location to redeem.**
- Maximum of **ONE** guest pass voucher for members of the Governor's Circle of the Colonial Williamsburg Associates (gifts of \$3,500-\$4,999.99).
- Maximum of **TWO** guest pass vouchers for members of the Raleigh Tavern Society (gift of \$5,000+)

- Passes are **NOT** transferrable to multiple guests. Once redeemed, one pass works for one specific individual only.
- Passholders are entitled to all standard annual passholder benefits

Access to the St. George Tucker House

- Members who make gifts of more than \$250 (Capitol Society, Colonial Williamsburg Assembly, Colonial Williamsburg Burgesses, Colonial Williamsburg Associates and Raleigh Tavern Society) can access the St. George Tucker House daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Art Museum Admission

A financial statement is on file with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Affairs in the Commonwealth of Virginia. For tax purposes, gifts to the Foundation may be claimed as charitable contributions in the year of the donation. However, under IRS rules, any deduction(s) must be reduced by the value of goods or services received in exchange for the gift(s). Donors wishing to make their contribution fully deductible for tax purposes must decline formally in writing all goods or services at the time of the contribution. The chart below summarizes the non-deductible value of goods and services associated with donor society memberships.

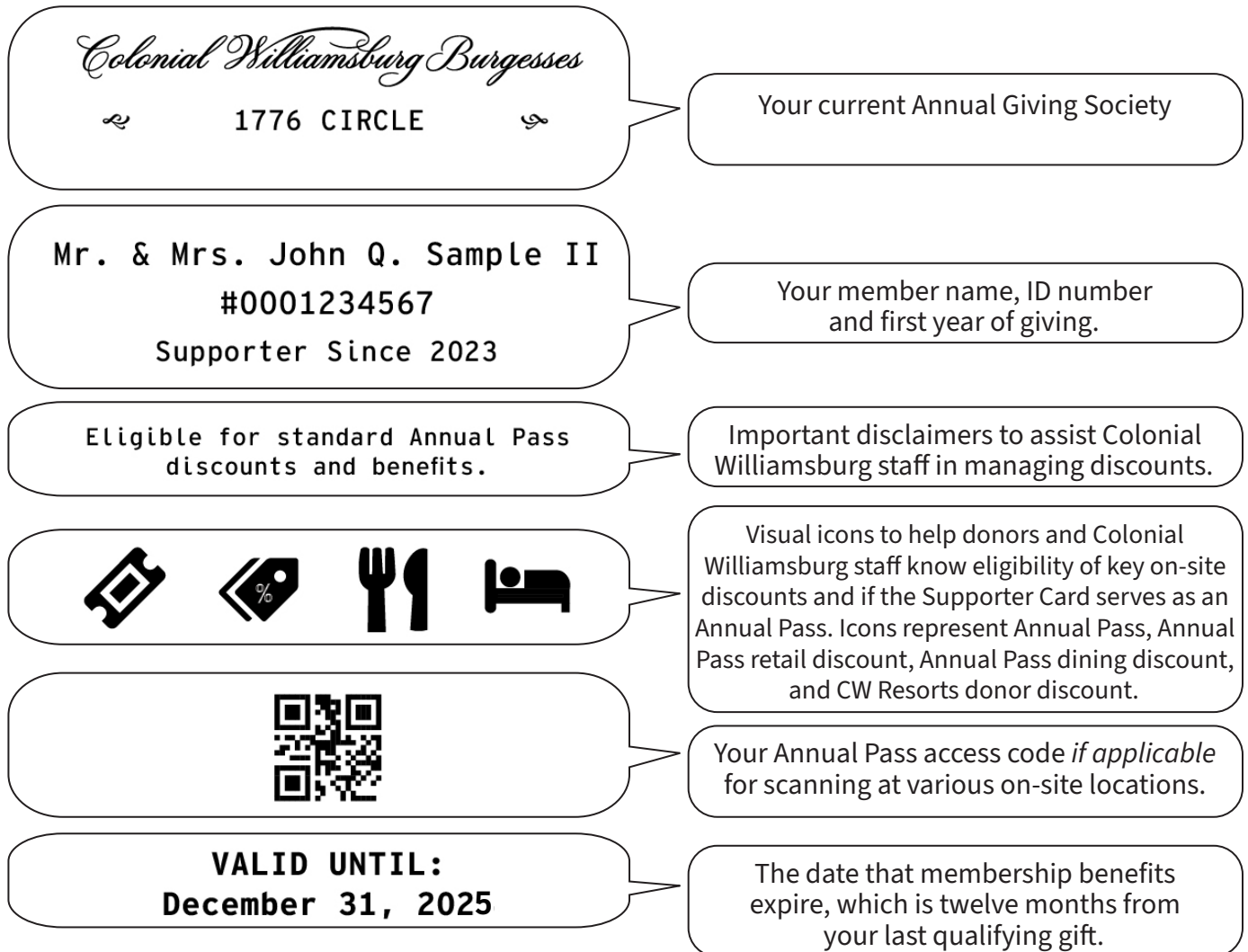

Your 2025 Supporter Card includes functionality to make your on-site experience more seamless as you move throughout Colonial Williamsburg's Historic Area, Art Museums, resorts, taverns and stores.

Your card explained...



- If a ticket icon appears, your Supporter Card can be used as an Annual Pass so a physical pass or ticket is not required for entry. Physical passes or tickets will not be issued to donors.
- Only the key discounts are represented. If the ticket icon appears, donor is also eligible for all standard Annual Pass benefits.
- If you are a W.A.R. Goodwin Society member, you will receive a separate card for that membership.
- Always bring your Supporter Card with you.
- Please be patient with staff as we work to improve processes.
